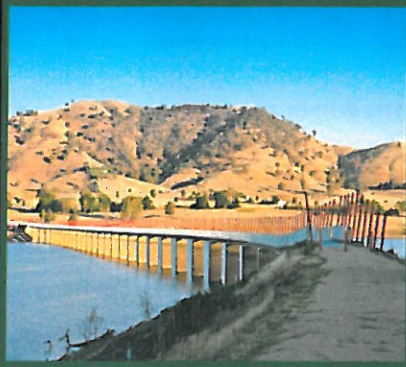

PLACES TO VISIT - SANDY CREEK BRIDGE, HUON

The new Sandy Creek Bridge spans Lake Hume 9km southwest of Tallangatta. It utilises the historic rail bridge pylons, providing an iconic rail trail bike link between Wodonga and Tallangatta that celebrates the region's history and its vibrant future. Drawing inspiration from the red oxide colouring of the original bridge beams, the Sandy Creek Bridge is defined by the repetition of bold red sculptural elements that allow for striking views over the lake and replicate the flowing forms of the rolling hills beyond, creating a playful insertion in the landscape. The Sandy Creek Bridge celebrates the history and movement of travellers past, present and future, opening up the landscape to visitors and establishing a bold new identity for the Tallangatta region. It can be walked or cycled on at anytime.

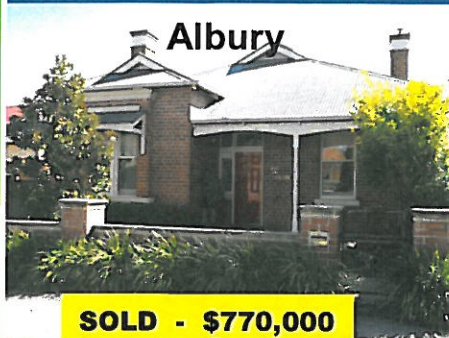

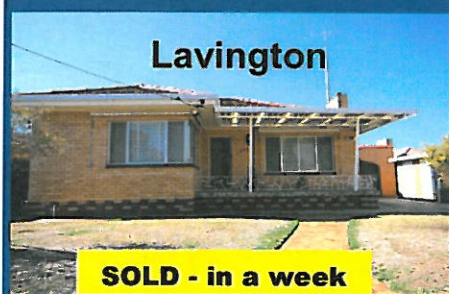

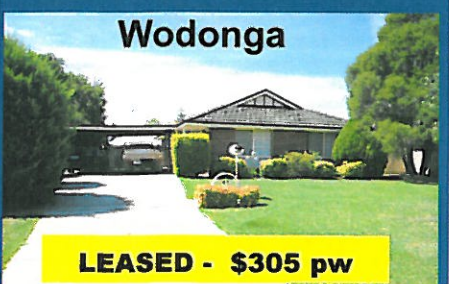

QUICK CREAMY CHICKEN AND SWEET POTATO BAKE



Ingredients:

1.1kg sweet potatoes, peeled, cut into 5mm-slices
300ml Bulla Creme Fraiche
125ml (1/2 cup) Bulla Cooking Cream
2 garlic cloves, crushed
1 tablespoon chopped fresh tarragon
200g meat from barbecue chicken, shredded
2 green shallots, chopped
105g (1 1/4 cups) grated cheddar cheese
heat oven to 200C/180C fan forced.

Method:

Place the sweet potato in a large microwave-safe bowl with 60ml (1/4 cup) water. Cover with two sheets of plastic wrap. Cook in the microwave on High for 8 minutes or until tender. Drain and set aside.

Meanwhile, lightly grease a 6cm-high 30 x 20cm (base measurement) baking dish. Combine the Bulla Creme Fraiche, Bulla Cooking Cream, garlic and tarragon in a jug. Season.

Layer the sweet potato, chicken, shallot and 80g (1 cup) of the cheese in the prepared dish, pouring a little of the cream mixture between each layer. Pour the remaining cream mixture over the top. Scatter over the remaining cheese and bake for 30-35 minutes or until golden and the cheese is melted and bubbling. Set aside for 10 minutes before serving.
